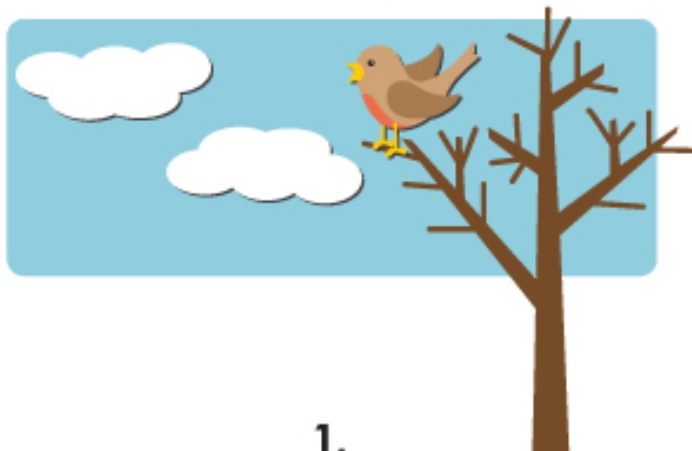
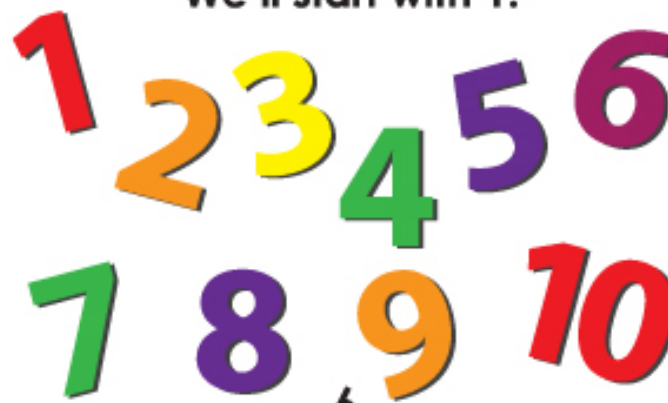

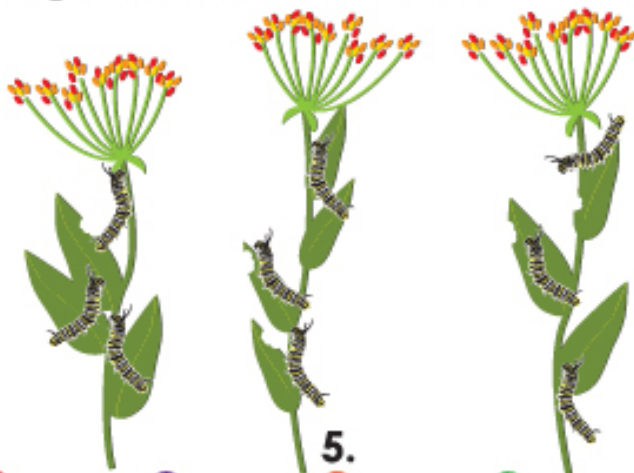
Ask your child these questions after sharing the story (if he/she is verbal). These are open-ended questions so in most cases, there is not a "right" or "wrong" answer.
