Does the curriculum utilize a hands-on approach to learning?
Is the curriculum easy-to-understand/follow?

Is the curriculum based on early childhood research?
Is the curriculum aligned and/or approved with your state standards?
Is the curriculum supported by training?
Is the curriculum designed for use in a home environment? (e.g., does it use materials you have on hand?)
Does the curriculum provide supporting materials?
Does the curriculum help you build skills as a provider every day and in a hands-on way?
Is the curriculum affordable?
Does the curriculum include a mix of whole group, small group and individual experiences?
Does the curriculum include indoor & outdoor activities?
Does the curriculum include tools for family involvement?
Does the curriculum recognize the diversity of families?
Is the curriculum able to be utilized with your choice of formal child assessment tools?
